Humanity Renewed

IN HIM WAS LIFE, AND THE LIFE WAS THE LIGHT OF MEN.
THE LIGHT SHINES IN THE DARKNESS,
AND THE DARKNESS HAS NOT OVERCOME IT.

JOHN [:4-5>

1) A Crucial Introduction For Knowing God

- a) One of the most important truths in the Bible about God is that He is One (Deuteronomy 6:4). There is none greater than God, and He alone is the God who reveals Himself as the One God to His people (Deuteronomy 4:35-40).
- b) At first glance, John's introduction of God being in the beginning "with the Word" seems like 'no big deal.' But then, the Word is revealed as the active divine person who created all things (John 1:1-3).
- c) You can imagine how radical it was for John to write that Jesus was "the Word who became flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:14). Jesus was the human person who was also the divine Word, God in human flesh for all to see (John 1:18).
- d) John wants to make sure we understand this truth from the beginning! Jesus was 100% human, and He was 100% divine!
- e) The "one-ness" of God was revealed to mankind as unity in essence, will, glory, and eternity. But the personhood of God was revealed as God the Father, God the Son, and (we will see later) God the Holy Spirit. "God in trinity and the trinity in unity" (as written in the Athanasian Creed).

2) The Cosmic Battle Continues

- a) John's poetic introduction to his Cospel account also introduces us to Jesus Christ as "the true light, which gives life and light to everyone" but cannot be "overcome by the darkness" (John 1:4-5, 9).
- b) Here again the echoes of the cosmic battle between Satan and God are revisited (Genesis 3). The word for "overcome" (John 1:5, sometimes rendered "grasp," or "comprehend," or "extinguish") had a kind of dual spiritual & physical meaning.
 - First, it meant to comprehend or grasp hold of something with your mind. In this sense, the darkness is trying to comprehend the light, to intellectually grasp the light.
 - Second, it also meant to seize something by force with your hand, usually in a hostile and violent manner. The darkness was trying to overtake the light, to be its champion.
- c) John's Cospel account begins with this simple metaphor of darkness and light, but it reminds us there is a cosmic battle between Cod and Satan filled with hostility and violence in which all of mankind finds itself. This darkness is where Satan dwells and thrives. Terrible things happen in the darkness in John's Cospel account, it is the realm in which Satan thrives and mankind suffers.
- d) Sadly, even most of Cod's own people (the Jews) do not welcome the light of Jesus in their lives, much like most of the world (John 1:10-11). But to those who "receive," to those who "believe" (John 1:12-13)...
- e) There is a responsibility we bear to respond to God's "grace upon grace" (John 1:16) by receiving & believing, to "become children of God, born of God" (John 1:12-13). Is God "dwelling" with you, is He the light of your life?


